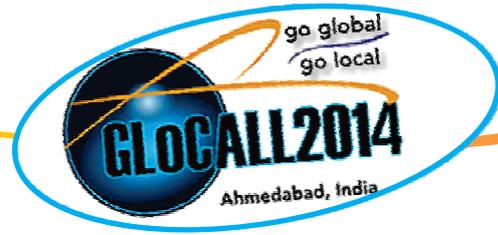
ABOUT THE COLLEGE
